SPIRITUAL WARFARE

Reference Scriptures: Isaiah 26:3; Eph 6:10; II Cor 10:4; II Cor 10:4-10; Rom 8:28

What is warfare?

- A battle of opposing forces; committing some type of action against each other.
- When engaged in warfare, we fought with weapons that God has given us that are more powerful than any physical weapon.
- A stronghold is something that has a vantage over you. A place that Satan has setup to take advantage over you.
- No stronghold is pulled down without the power of God.
- God has given us His Spirit. He will give you the spirit of discernment.
- Spiritual warfare is an attack of your faith. Satan wants to intimidate you and make you doubt God. He wants to bring fear to us and we can never win by being afraid.
- When the enemy comes in and tries to tear everything up, we have to rise up in the spirit of the Lord and fight.
- We fight by going into prayer, by going into praise, getting into the word, by asking the Holy Spirit for a refilling; to be revived, refreshed and rejuvenated – that's how we win. We have to learn how to shut the enemy down by quoting scripture; by going back to the bible.

7 Pieces of Armor

1. Belt of Truth
 2. Breastplate of righteousness

 - We execute warfare through the high praises.
 - We have to dress up in the armor to go into battle.
 - The bible tells us the enemy is like a roaring lion seeking those that are weak. And he can tear you up while you are out there.
