## THE HOLY SPIRIT

### Reference Scriptures:

John 14:16; Matt 28:19; Acts 5:1-11; Isa 26:3; 1 John 5:7;  
John 14:26; Acts 16:7; 1Cor 12:11; Acts 2:4; 2 Tim 1:7

- Who is the Holy Spirit?
  - The Comforter
  - The Third Person of the Trinity
- The Holy Spirit is that person sent by God to help us.
- Paraclete – comes within us to help us carry out the mission that God has given us.
- It is impossible to carry out the mandate of God without the Holy Spirit.
- Since the Holy Spirit has been sent, we need to let Him help us.
- Believers can be refilled everyday with the Holy Spirit.
- We are blessed because we can receive Him.
- The world cannot receive the Holy Spirit
  - *He cannot dwell in an unclean temple.*
  - *The world does not know of His Spirit.*
  - *The world has turned its back upon God.*
  - *The world does not know Him.*
- The Holy Spirit comes in to lift up the Christ in you. He comes to make you a drawing card to those in the world.

- The Holy Spirit is:
  - Omnipotent - All Powerful Rom 15:19
  - Omniscient - All Knowing 1 Cor 2:11
  - Omnipresent - Everywhere 1 Cor 12:11
- The devil is not everywhere. He has it so organized that he can plague you all over the world.
  - Everywhere you go you will find demonic spirits.
- The Holy Spirit comes to:
  - Influence
  - Help
  - Assist
  - Keep you
- The Holy Spirit is called:
  - Spirit of God
  - Spirit of Christ
  - Spirit of the Lord
  - Spirit of Adoption
  - Spirit of Holiness
  - Spirit of Judgment
- If the Spirit of God is not influencing you – then who is?
