## *The Kings Series*

### Reference Scriptures: 1 Samuel

- There are 8-9 dominant spirits that try to rule:
  - Disobedience
  - Jealousy
  - Hatred
  - Rebellion
  - Lustful
  - Spirit of manipulation
  - Pride
  - Fear
  - Deception
- These spirits are trying to come in the church through the people.
- God has always had a king in the earth. The first king was Adam (Gen 1:28) God gave him authority over the earth and the authority to name everything in the Garden of Eden.
  - Adam gave up his authority when he sinned.
- Gen 3:
  - Eve had the authority to resist the devil but she did not.
  - Adam and his wife hid themselves from God. They were in relationship with God until they sinned. They then hid from God.
  - Why should a King hide?
- When you are in authority there is always a relationship.
  - A Pastor should be in relationship with the flock.
  - A father should be in relationship with his son.
  - A President should be in relationship with his cabinet.
- Adam and Eve were in a broken relationship
  - All of the kings of Israel were in broken relationships.
  - Saul died because he went away from the things of God and consulted a witch.

- We are kings and queens and we cannot handle things that God calls dirty.
- There is a lot of deception, favoritism, jealousy in the lives of the kings.
- Saul was the first king of Israel
  - The people wanted a king and Saul was chosen.
  - Saul was anointed by God as king.
