1. Adoration – esteem; adore
2. Confessing what the word says about who you are.
3. Thanksgiving – giving thanks for all that He has done. From a grateful heart.
4. Supplication – making your requests known

Praise and Worship reminds God of the sacrifices of the Priests. *Heb 13:15; 1 Pet 2:9*

1. God commands us to praise Him.

Phil 2:9-11; Psalms 67:3; Psalms 9:11; Psalms 22:34; 1 Cor 16:29

* Bonus Study – Go back through the bible and find examples of how people obtained victory through their praise.

2. God is worthy of our praise.

Psalms 63:34; 2 Chronicles 5:13

* The noise of praise is carried to heaven on the winds of the air. Praise then reaches the throne room of God.

3. Praise is the ordained way of entering into His presence. Praise is the gate that leads into His presence.

Isaiah 62:10; Psalms 9:14; Psalms 22:3; Psalms 24:7-10; Psalms 118:19-21

4. Praise and worship are ways of glorifying God.

Psalms 50:23

* God is glorified by the one who praises Him.

5. Praising is a good witness to others of the goodness (testimony) of God

Psalms 40:3

Why we need to praise God?

1. Praise helps us to become more God-centered.
2. Praise and worship are ways of staying our mind on Him. *Isaiah 6:23*
3. Praise and Worship help us to develop our love relationship with Him.
