Spiritual Warfare

Reference Scriptures: 2 Corinthians 10:1-4; Ephesians 2:1; Matthew 4:1-4; Joshua 1:8; Revelation 1:3; Revelation 22

- When we get saved, we took on the Spirit of God. His divinity took on our humanity.
- Our walk is now a walk of warfare.
- We are always attached to the Adamic nature.
- We are tripod beings; composed of:
 - o Body
 - o Soul
 - o Spirit
- The old nature cannot inherit the kingdom of God.
- We are assigned purpose and the enemy comes to stop us.
- What weapons I have to overcome the enemy?
 - o What weapon will we use to combat fear?
 - Give the devil back the word of God.
- We have to be bold and start quoting the word to the devil when he comes -
 - o We have to rehearse the word of the Lord, daily.
- Satan doesn't care if we can quote scripture but he wants to know if the scripture lives on the inside of us.
- We have to stay in the word – we need a bible; mediate in it (ponder it; chew on it; throw it back up and chew it again.)
- Life is in the word and we need to speak the word in our life.

- What are our weapons of warfare:
 - o The word of God.
 - o Prayer
 - o Fasting
 - o Praise
 - Nullifies the enemy's attack. When you should be discouraged, praise steps in and takes us to another level.
